



SUMMER 2018 HOUSING INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible to live in the University Residence Halls for summer term, you must be an admitted student at UW-Madison, be enrolled for at least 1 summer credit with the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and have a UW-Madison ID number (10 digits).

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for summer housing, simply fill out an online application. The online application can be found by going to: www.housing.wisc.edu/residence-halls/assignments/summer/. Housing contracts are offered based on date of application.

GENERAL RESIDENCE HALL INFORMATION

Conveniently located on campus, University Residence Halls are within walking distance of campus facilities, city bus stops, dining facilities, and many other attractions. In 2018, summer term housing will be offered in Kronshage Hall. Kronshage Hall is equipped with air conditioning units. Rooms have wireless internet coverage and are wired for Cable TV service; however, they are not equipped with telephone or land line service. Laundry costs \$2.50 per load; dryers are free. Laundry facilities are located in the lower levels of Conover and Showerman Houses of Kronshage.

DINING SERVICE

University Housing Dining hours are limited during the summer. Dining options are available for use with your Wiscard at a variety of locations on campus when facilities are open. Check out our locations and hours at www.housing.wisc.edu/dining/locations/. Additionally, Kronshage hall is equipped with two shared kitchen facilities which students are able to use. Residents must bring their own cooking utensils, dishes, and silverware.

GENERAL CAMPUS INFORMATION

PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

UW Transportation Services, located on campus at 21 N Park St., operates all campus parking, campus buses, and bicycle and pedestrian services. Due to limited availability, on-campus parking is very rarely granted to students. That said, most students find getting around on campus without a car is easy to do. Take advantage of the frequent, free campus bus routes, a free city-wide Associated Students of Madison (ASM) bus pass for enrolled students, and a great walking and biking infrastructure.
